

At St. George's Public School, our Dress Code allows for the expression of individuality and personal choice while sustaining a respectful learning and teaching environment for the school community.

Specifically,

1. Staff and students are expected to wear clothing (and jewellery) appropriate for regular school activities where appropriate is defined as: free of inappropriate language and/or graphics (weapons; profanity; vulgarity; remarks/images which are discriminatory, derogatory, or offensively suggestive; advertising for products which are illegal for minors to purchase).
2. Footwear must be appropriate for safe participation in all types of school activities and be conducive to a positive learning environment (i.e. flip-flops in Physical Education). Students are encouraged to have indoor footwear with non-marking soles.
3. Sunglasses are not to be worn inside the school unless medically required.
4. Hats/head coverings are permitted as long as they do not interfere with the learning or safety of any student.

In the event of a dress code violation, a reasonable effort will be made to contact parents or guardians as well as discretely address the issue with the student. The dress code will be shared with teachers, parents/guardians, and students in September and again in April of each year, as well as posted on the school website. All teachers and parents/guardians are encouraged to review the contents of the dress code with students. The final decision will rest with the administration.
